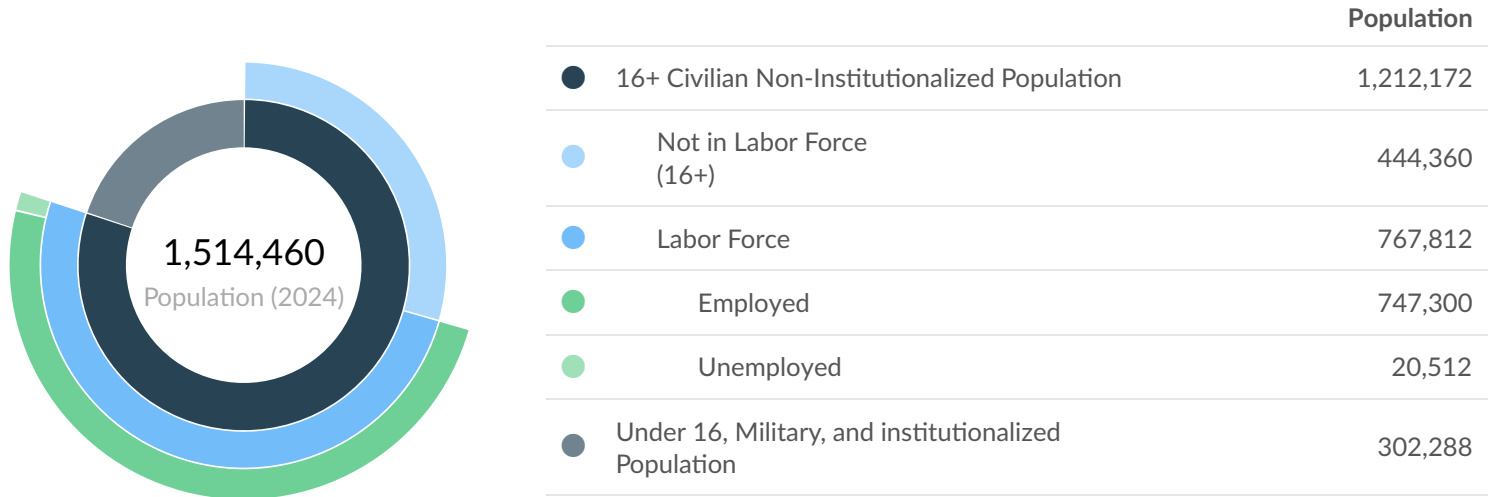
Regional average earnings per job are **\$11.5K below** the national average earnings of \$83.3K per job.

- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **increased by 0.7%** in South Central PA Works from 731,783 to **736,614**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 3.8%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 65.1% to 63.9% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.1% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.0% below the national average), and **9.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Warehousing and Storage, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).

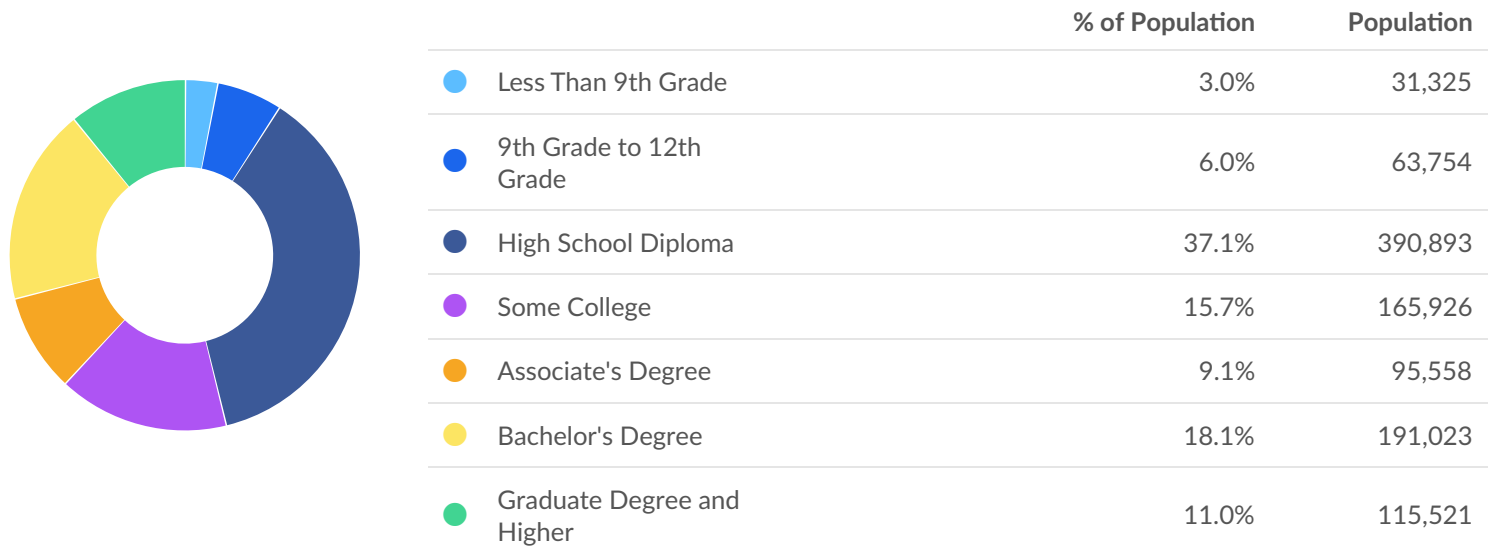

Sep 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



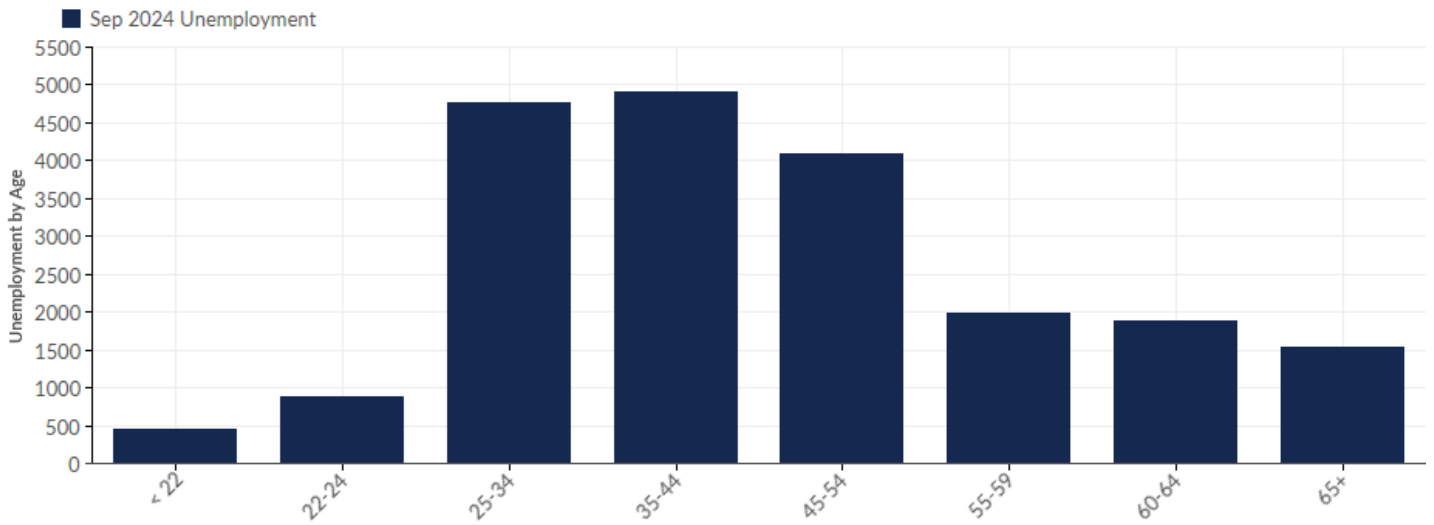
Educational Attainment

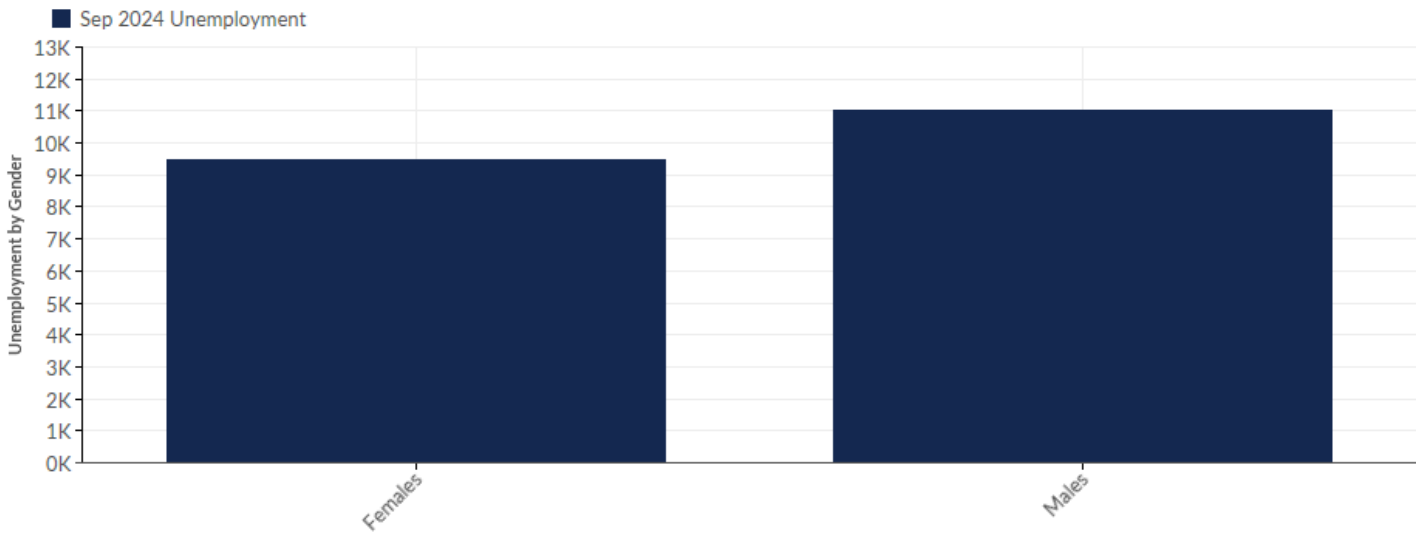

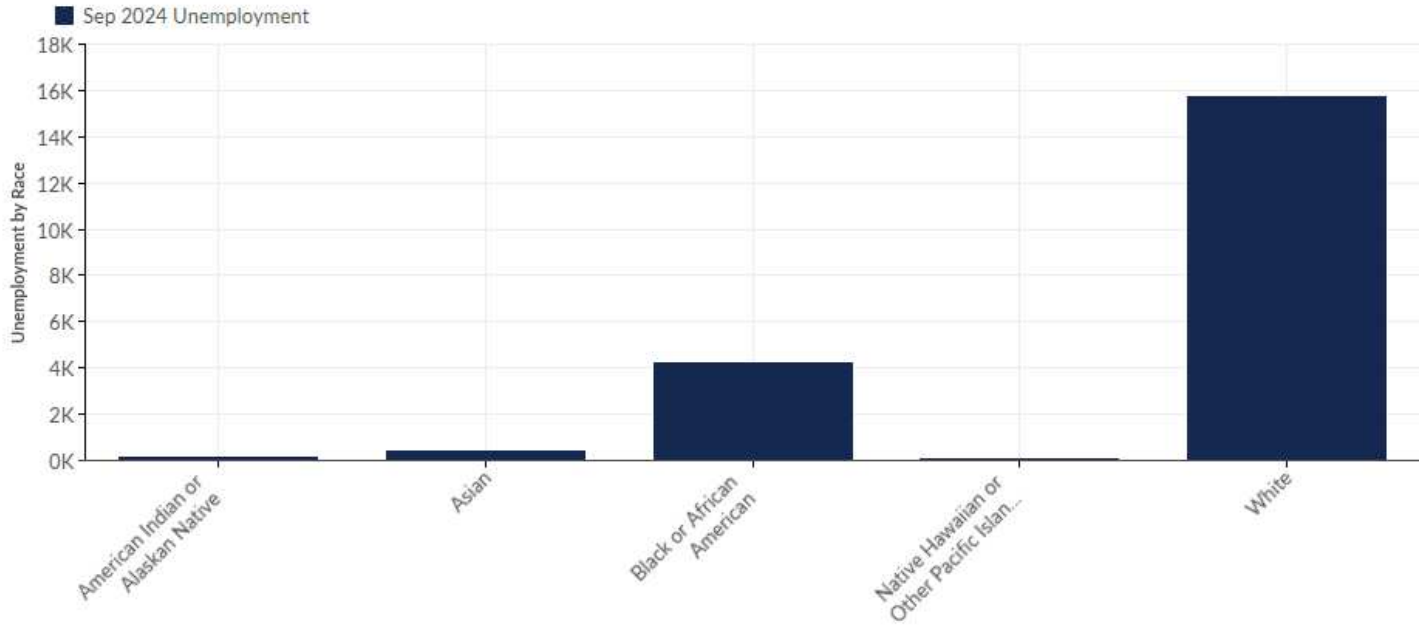

Unemployment by Gender



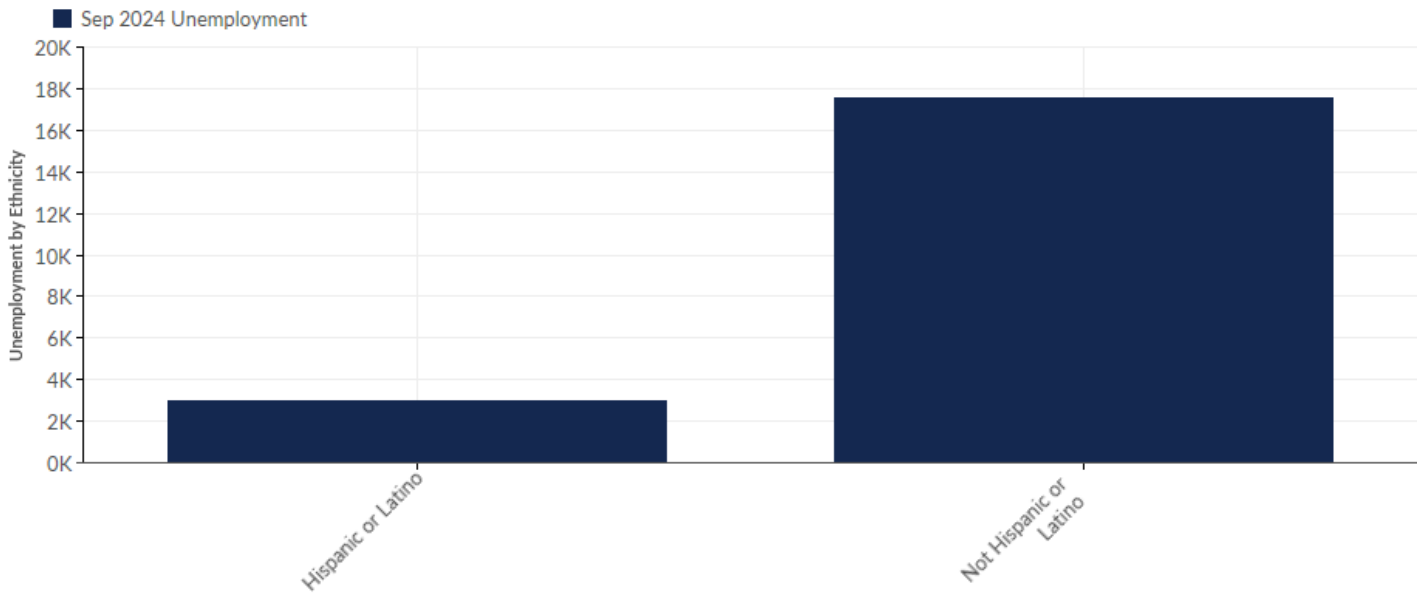

Unemployment by Ethnicity

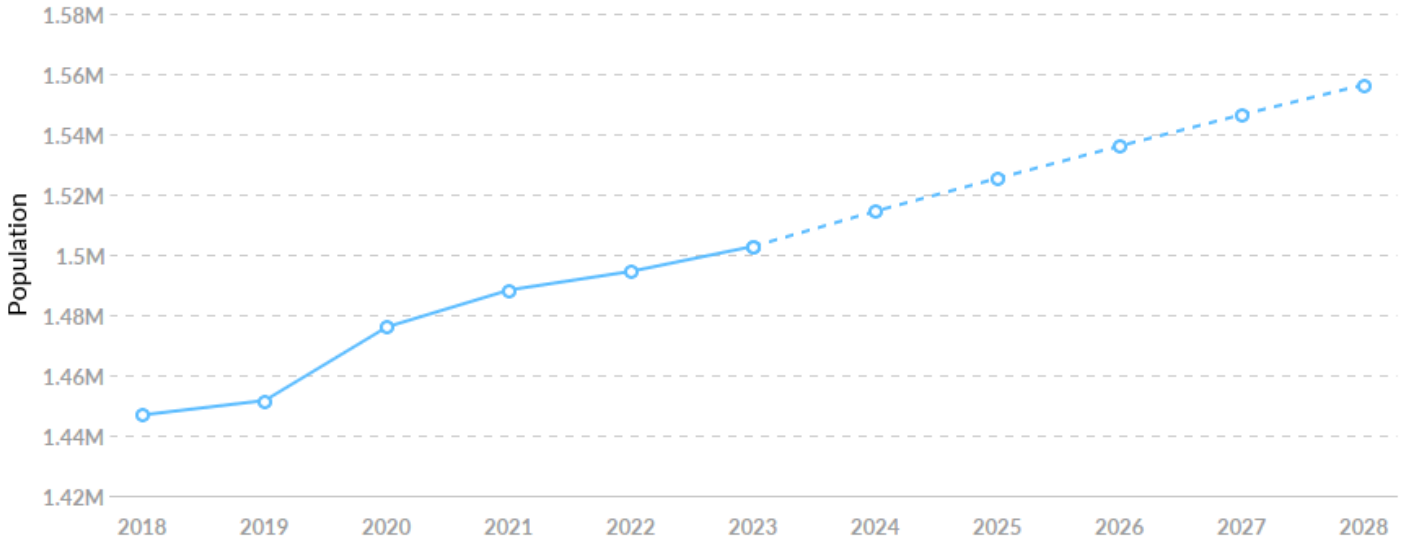

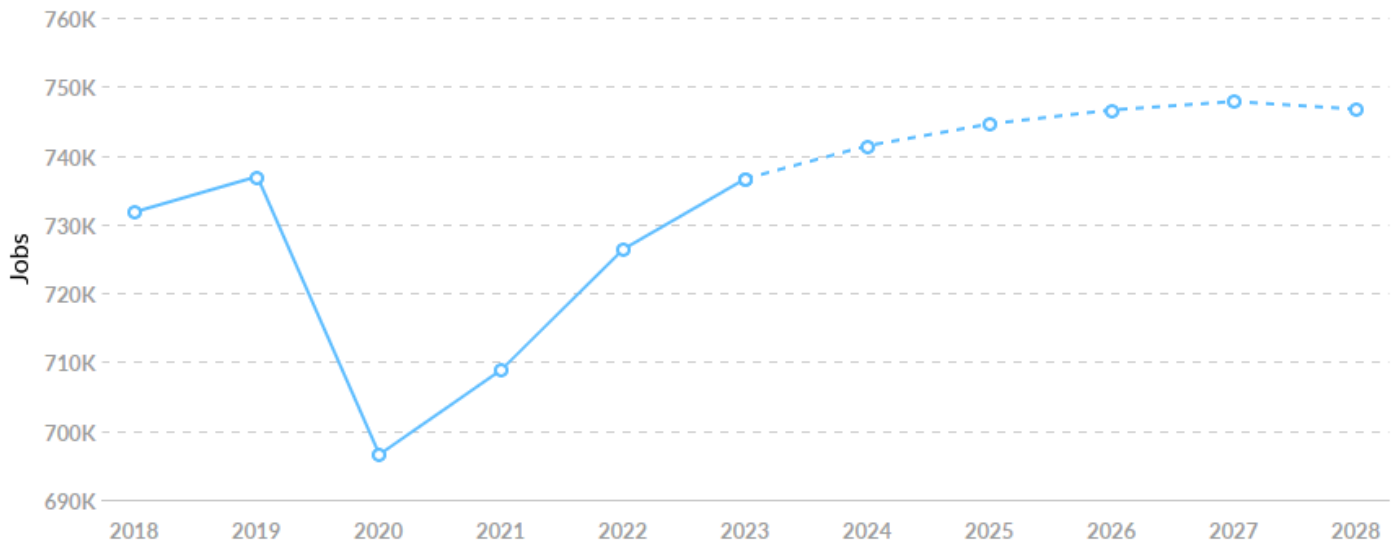

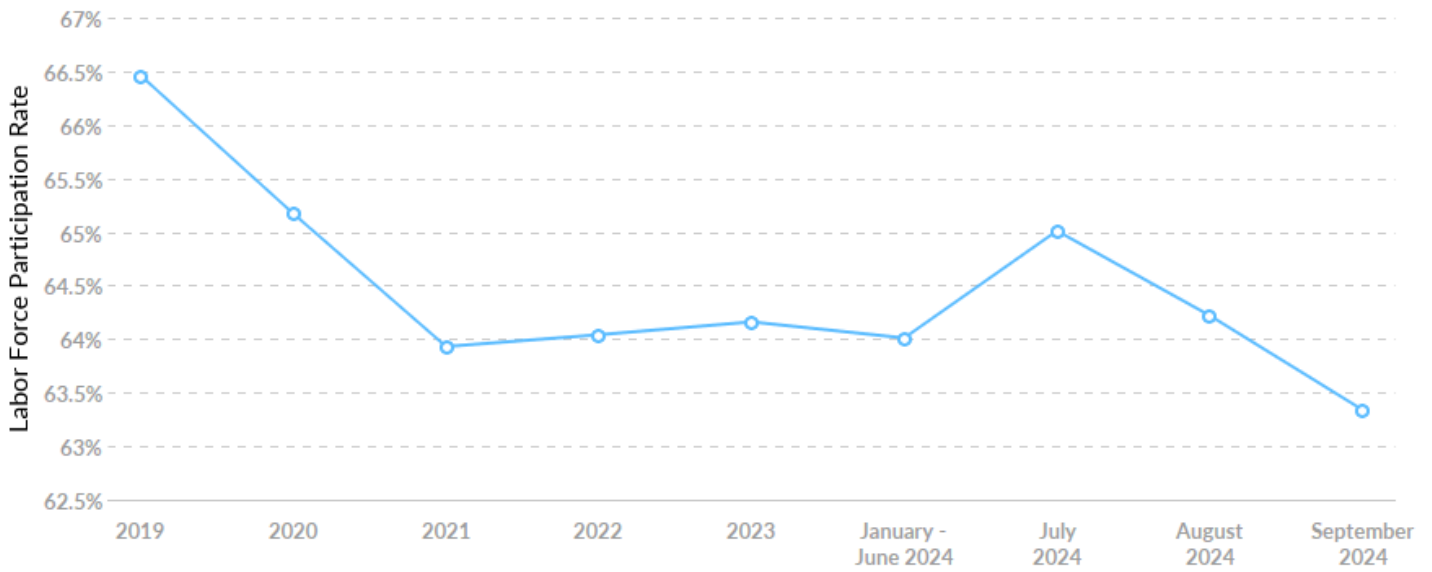
Job Trends

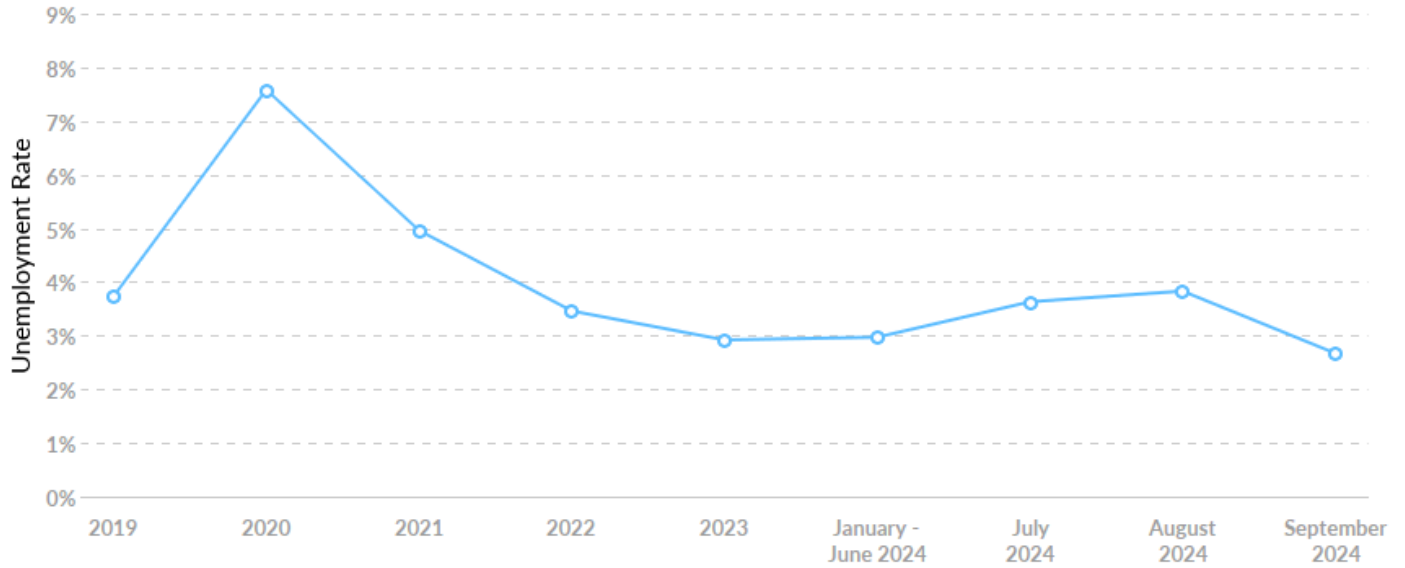

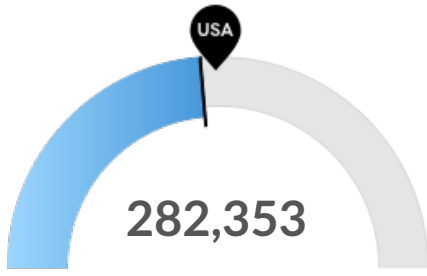

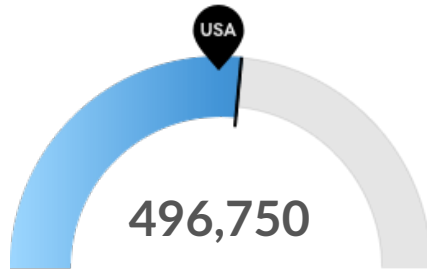

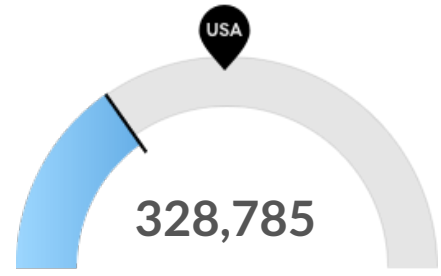
Millennials

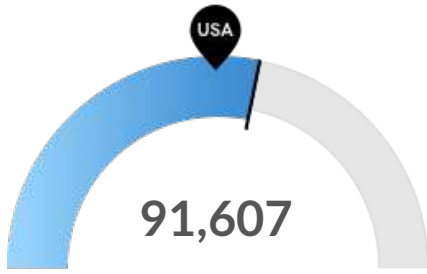
Retiring Soon

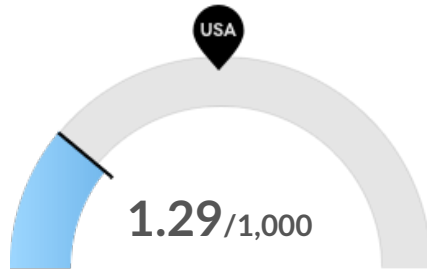

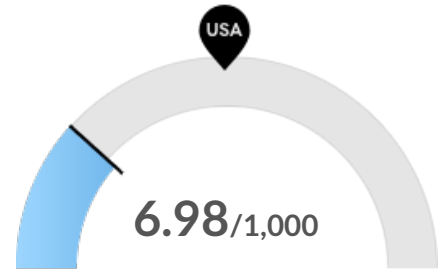

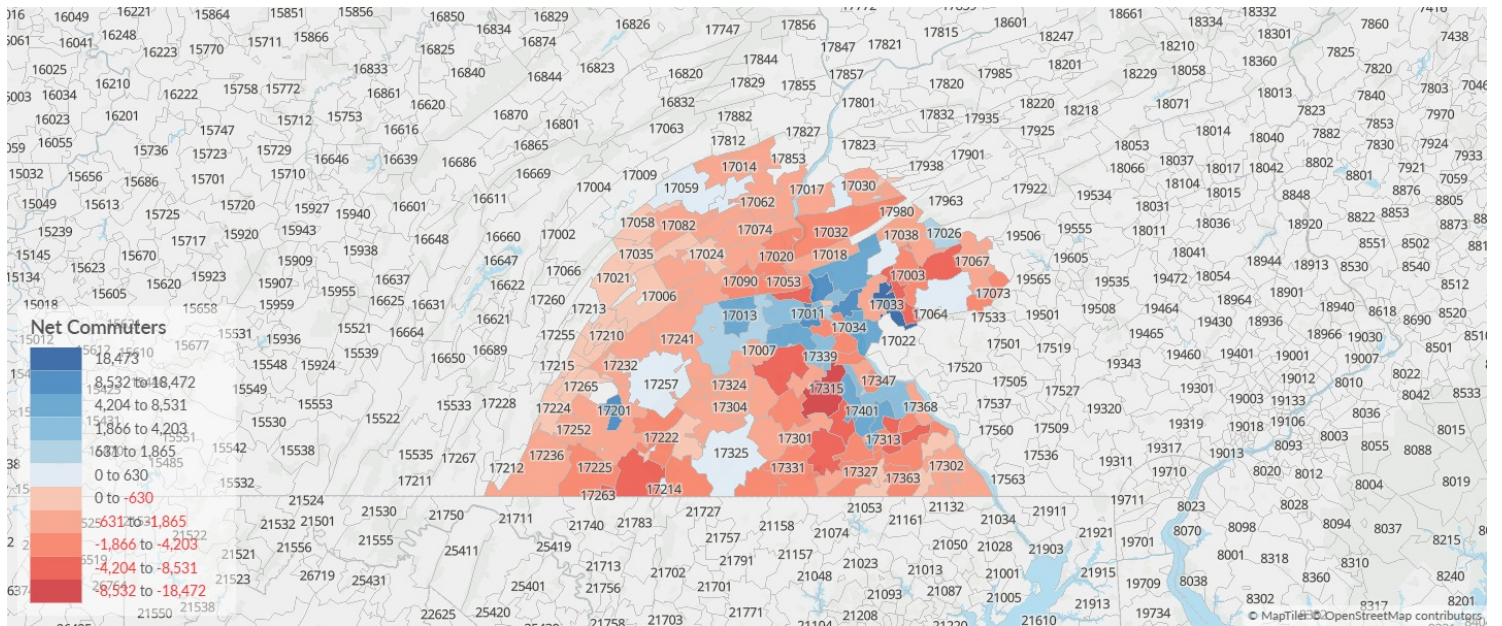

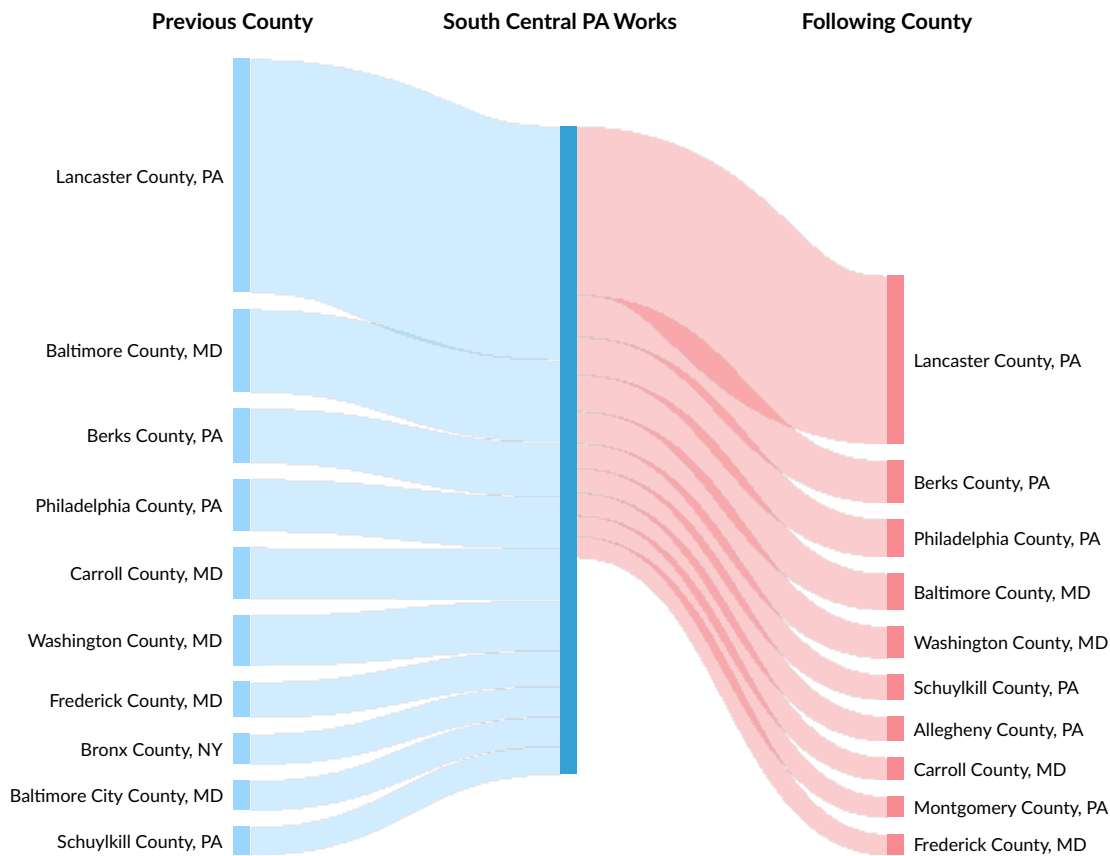

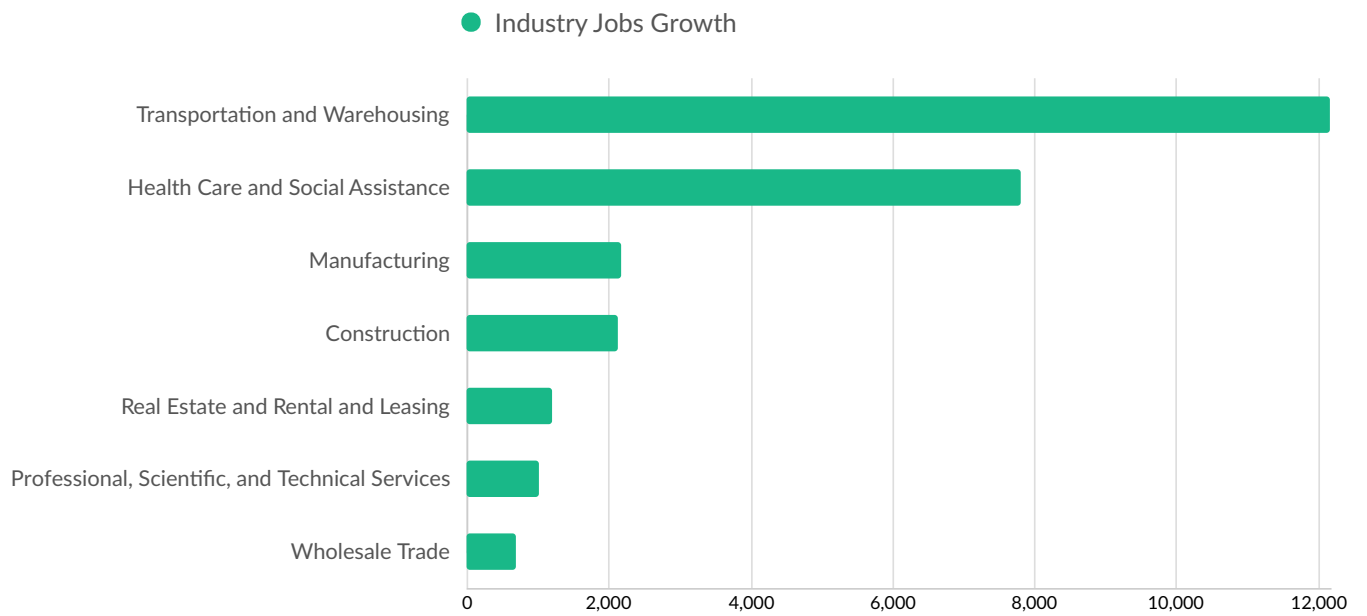

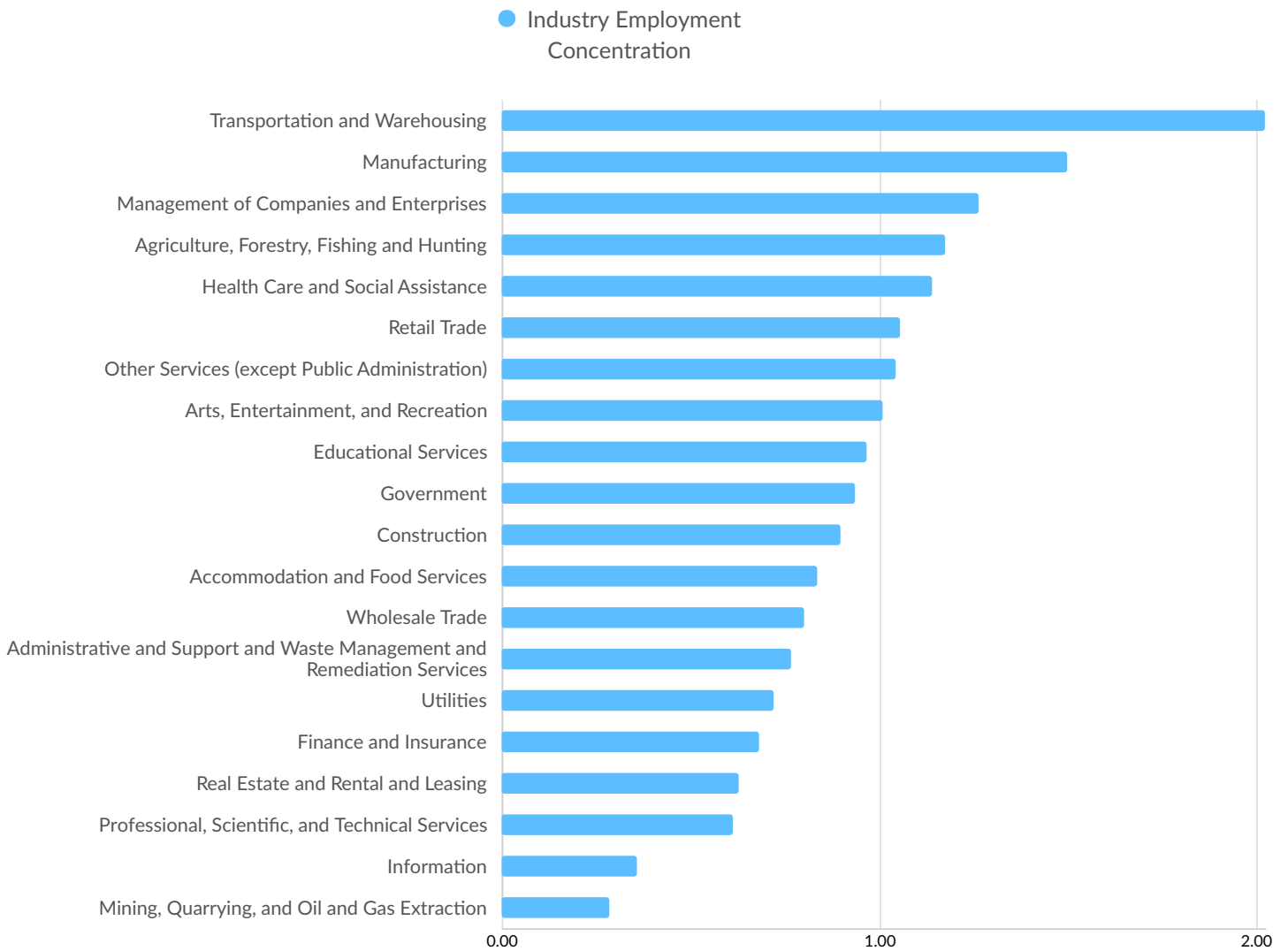

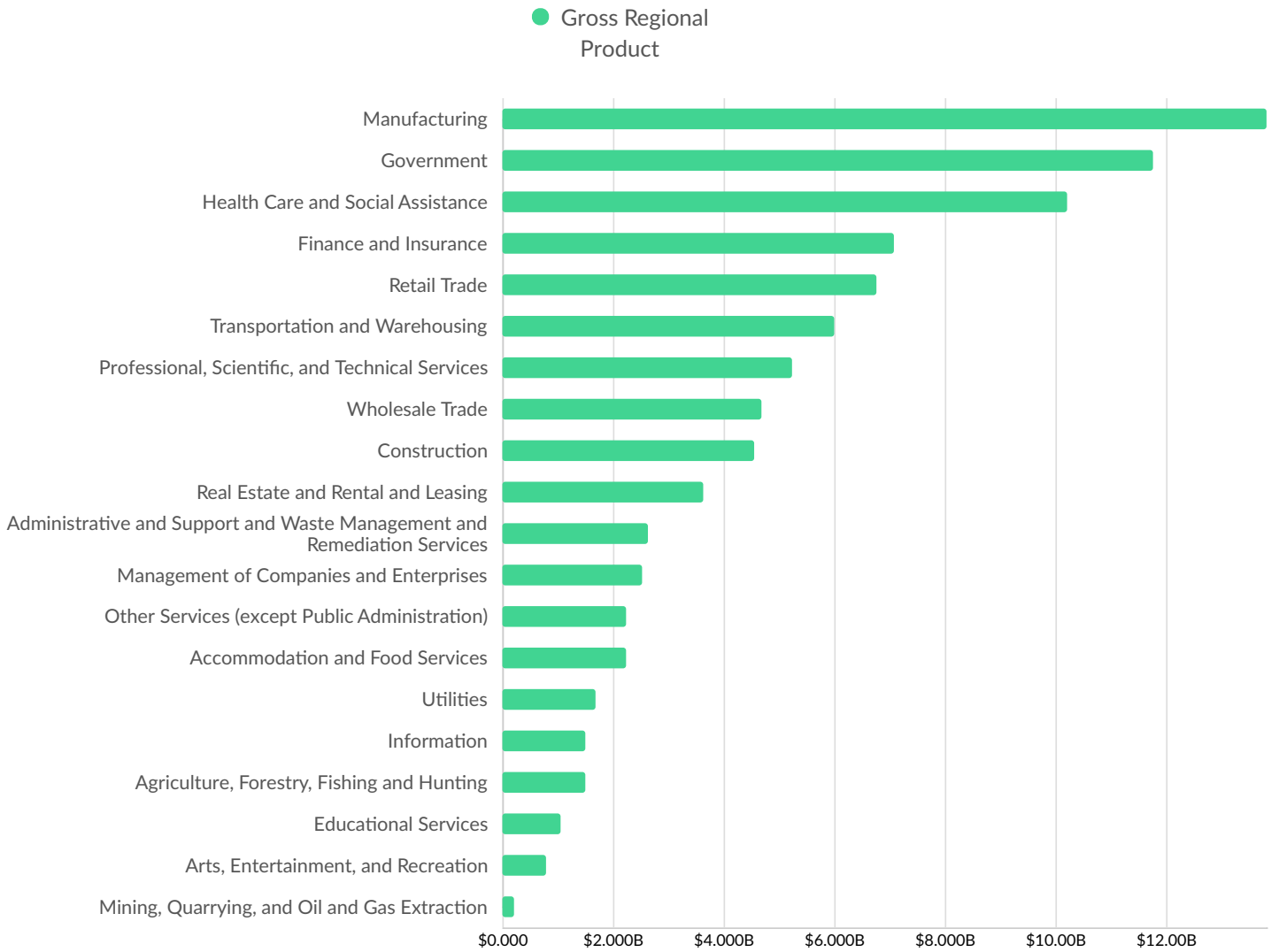
Top Growing Industries



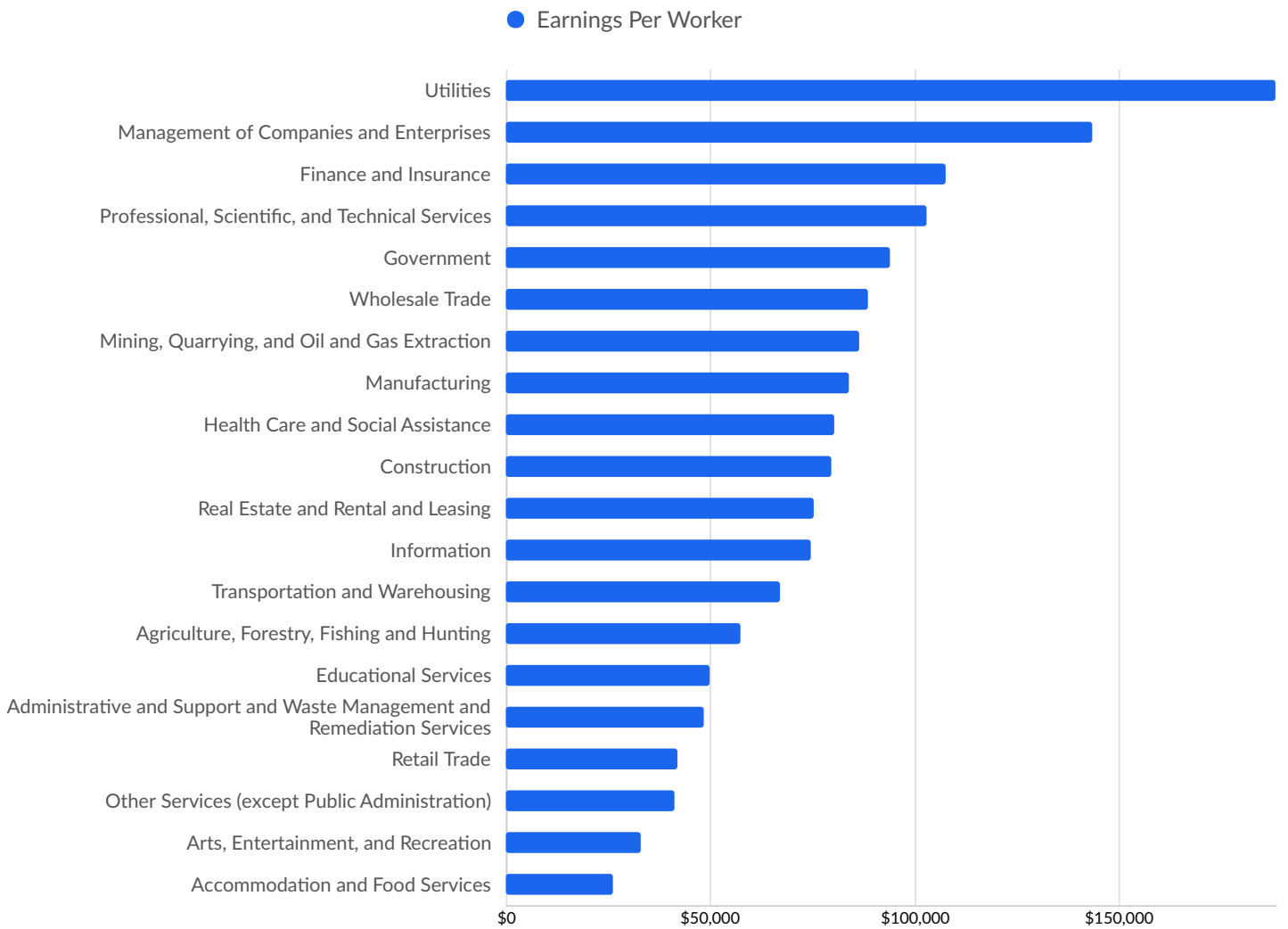
Top Industry Employment Concentration

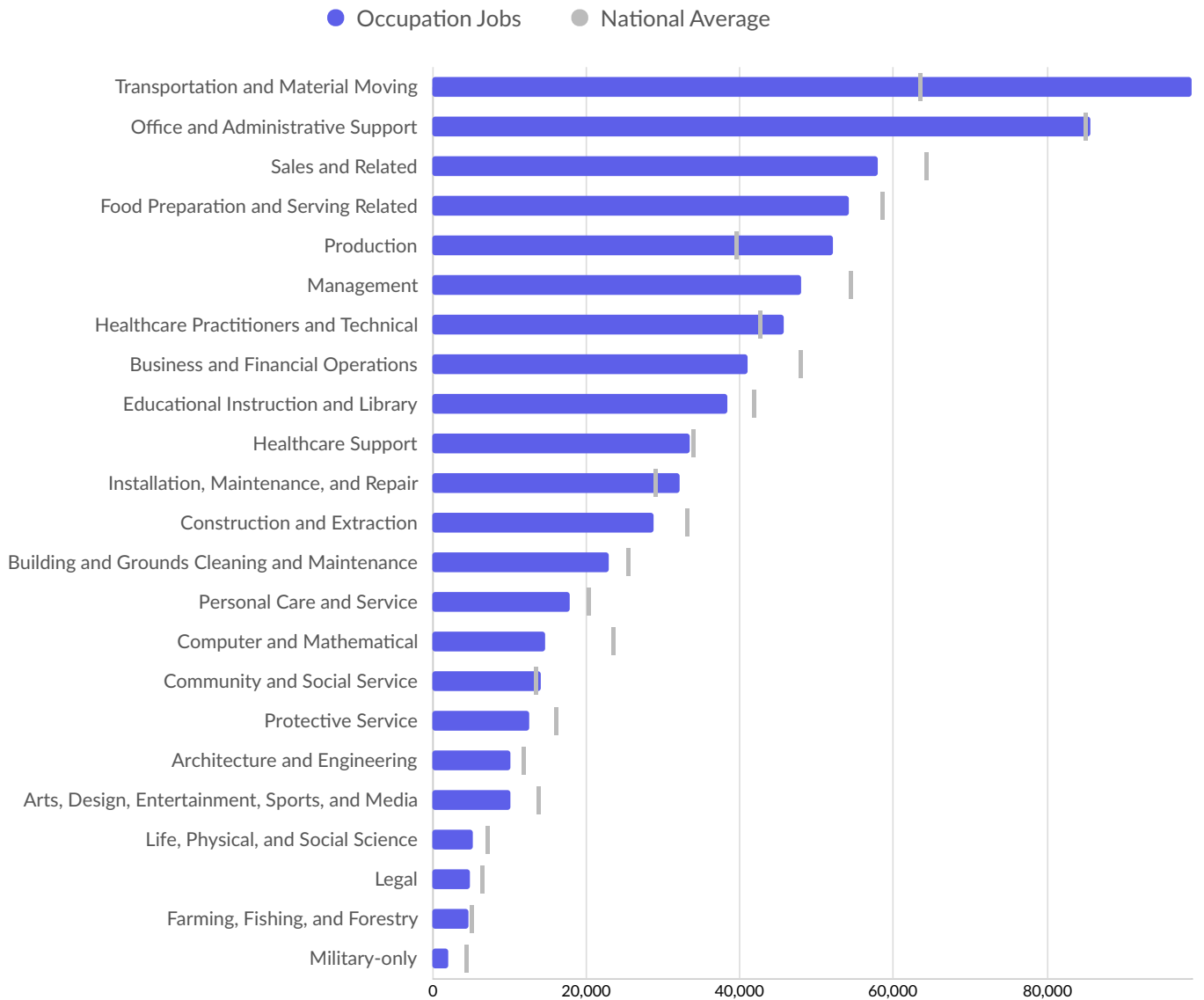

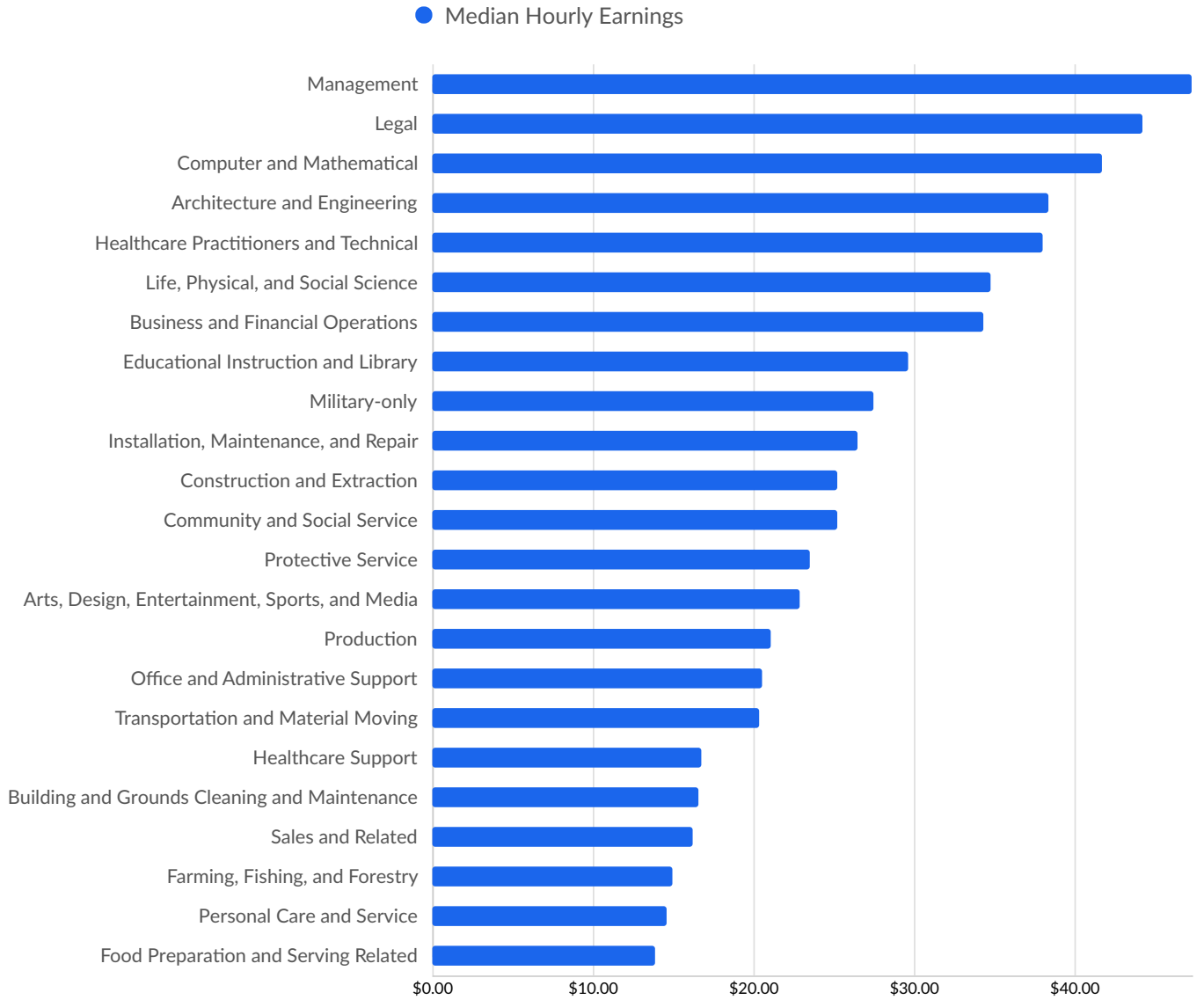


Top Occupation Employment Concentration

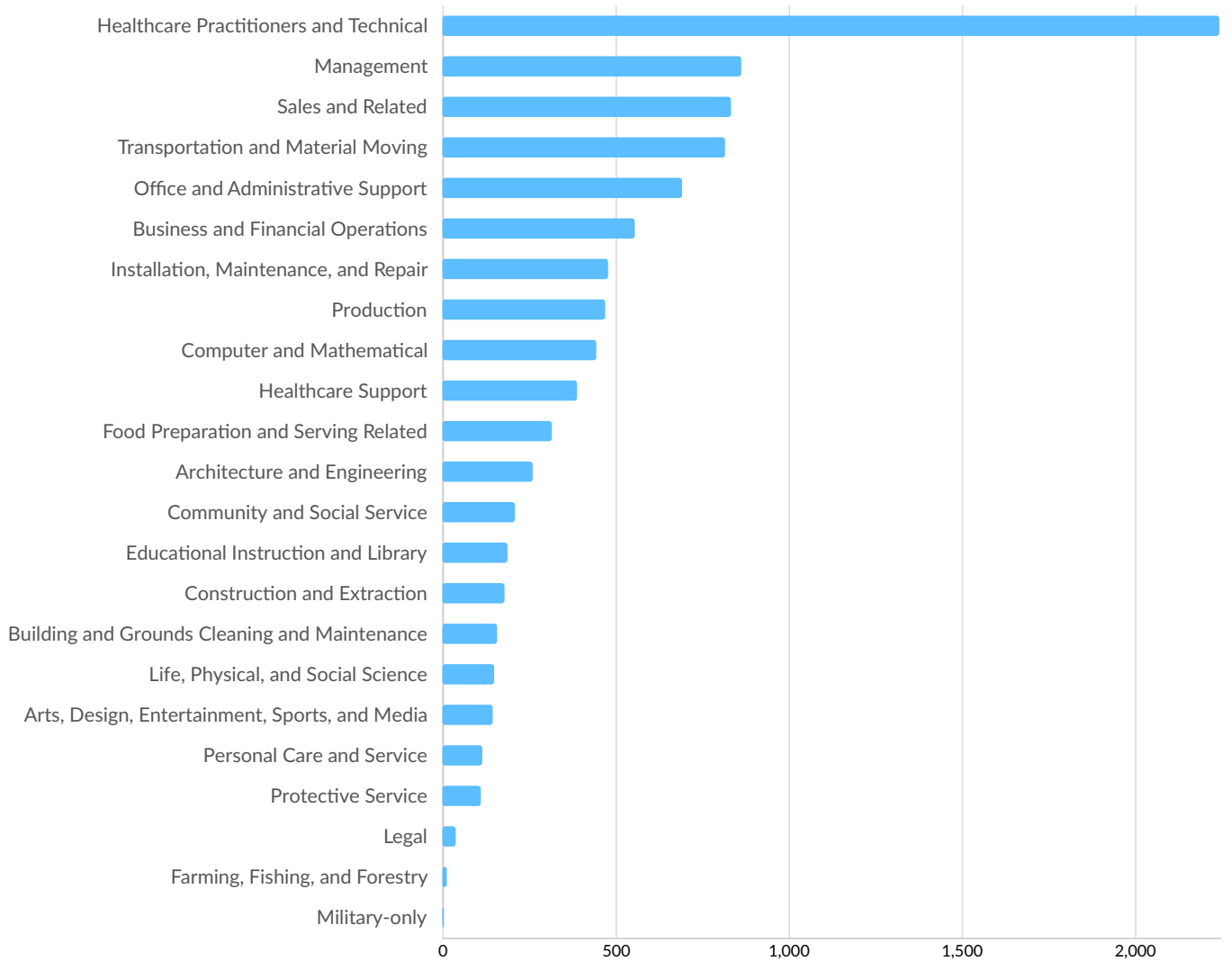


Top Occupation Earnings

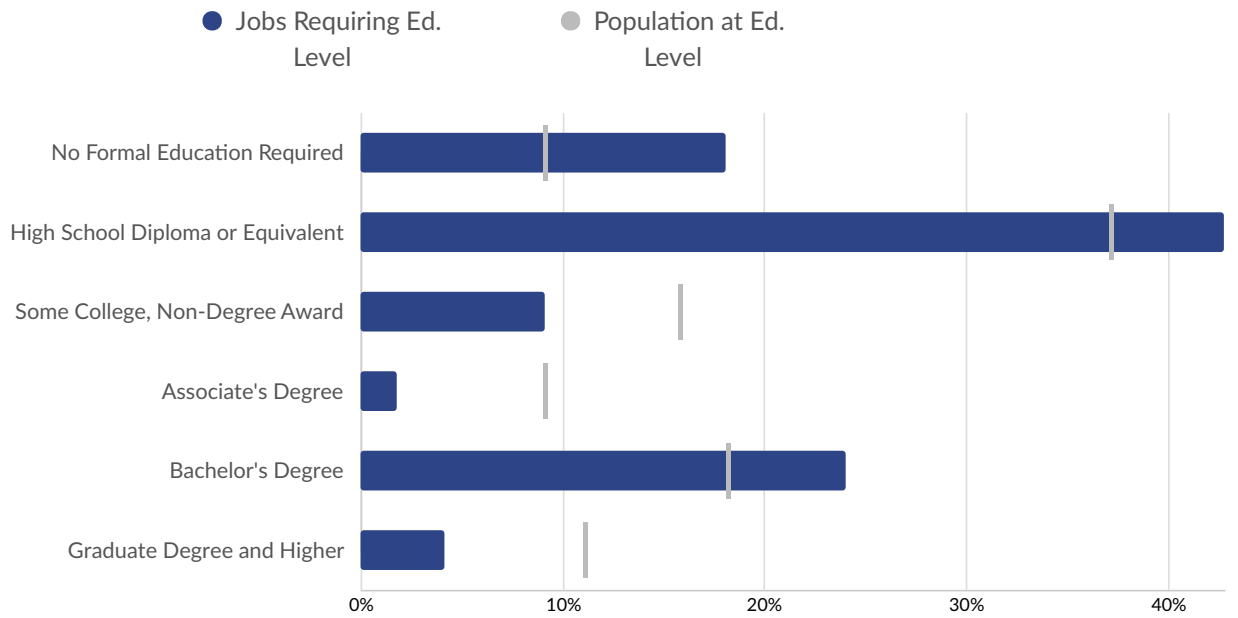
