

Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) RFQOuestions & Answers

Question: Will all awardees be expected to serve all 8 counties?

Answer: No, an awardee can propose to serve a specific county or counties.

Question: Are awardees allowed to subcontract with partners to deliver services? **Answer:** Yes, an awardee may sub-contract with partners to deliver services.

Question: My understanding from the call was that SCPa may fund a single proposal or multiple proposals. If an applicant proposes to serve all eight counties, will the total funding of \$550,000 be available to that one applicant? Or is the award for such a proposal still limited to \$120,000? **Answer:** Providers may propose any funding amount and number of counties to serve, consistent with their capacity and the contractual funding limit within \$550,000.

Question: Will all youth experiences be paid?

Answer: Yes, because the purpose of the Work Experience activity is to lead to paid work experience, re-engagement in secondary education, or employment.

Question: Does the funding amount include youth payment? **Answer:** Yes, the funding includes that for the individual.

Question: Should the proposed budget be in spreadsheet or narrative format?

Answer: Either is sufficient.

Question: The RFQ (page 11) says that quotes must be submitted electronically, in PDF format, in Responsive). However when I go into Responsive, it looks like we enter text directly into the portal. Is there no need for a PDF?

Answer: The PDF would need to be sent via email, to Judy Santiago at <u>jsantiago@scpaworks.org</u> if there is no option is seen to upload the document.

Question: The RFQ (page 8) says that applicants must provide letters supporting leveraged resources. Where in Responsive should we submit the letters?
